Day 01 SINGAPORE > ZURICH

Day 02 ZURICH - ZUG - STANS - LUCERNE

Dinne

- Zug The largest town and capital of the Swiss canton of Zug in Switzerland. Its name originates from the fishing vocabulary.
- The "Zuger Kirschtorte" (Zug cherry cake) is known as "The Specialty of Zug".
- Enjoy the famous cherry cake with a cup of coffee or tea.
- CabriO Cable Ride The world's first open-top aerial cable car. Trip begins with the historic funicular railway to midway station and change to the CabriO cableway and travel up the Mt. Stanserhorn rising 1,900 meters above sea level.
- Lucerne Photo stop at the Lion Monument. A gift from France to Switzerland to commemorate the valour of the Swiss Guards who defended King Louis XVI during the French Revolution.
- Old Chapel Bridge Lucerne's most photographed icon. *CabriO is open from 7th April - 28th November 2023 and subject to change.

Day 03 LUCERNE - ISELTWALD - GRUYÈRES -MONTREUX

Breakfast | Lunch

- Iseltwald Short drive to the beautiful green lake of Brienz, where you'll visit the old fishing village of Iseltwald. Take a walk around the charming streets or relax at the lakeshore. In the Korean drama "Crash Landing on You," Iseltwald was the setting for scenes of the main character Ri Jeong Hyoek attending music school in Switzerland.
- Gruyères Stop at a Cheese Factory to know more about the Gruyères cheese: Le Gruyère AOP is a cheese with a long tradition and its making has been handed down over many generations of cheesemakers both in the alpine and village cheese dairies.
- Montreux A traditional resort town on Lake Geneva. Nestled between steep hills and the lakeside, it's known for its mild microclimate and the Montreux Jazz Festival, held in July. The town's promenade is lined with flowers, sculptures, Mediterranean trees and grand Belle Époque buildings.



Day 04 MONTREUX - YVOIRE - ANNECY - GENEVA

Breakfast

- **Yvoire** Located at the foot of the Alps next to Lake Lemon, the largest natural lake in Western Europe, and across the lake from Switzerland. It is an ancient medieval village with a history of more than 700 years. Yvoire is one of the most beautiful villages in France.
- Annecy Is an alpine town in southeastern France, where Lake Annecy feeds into the Thiou River. It's known for its Vieille Ville (old town), with cobbled streets, winding canals, and pastel-coloured houses.
- **Geneva** Home to 150 World Organizations, including the United Nations. It is the most international city of Switzerland. Marvel at the distinctive beauty of "Jet d'Eau" (The Geneva Water Fountain).



Day 05 GENEVA - CHAMONIX - LYON

Breakfast | Dinner

- Chamonix A vibrant town known as both a world-class ski resort and a mountaineering destination. Situated in the Haute-Savoie region of France, it is bordered by Switzerland and Italy and dominated by the incredible Aiguilles de Chamonix Mountain chain peaking at the top of Mont Blanc (4810m).
- Aiguille du Midi The Aiguille du Midi is a 3,842-metre-tall mountain in the Mont Blanc massif within the French Alps. Experience it at the Aiguille du Midi (Chamonix Mont-Blanc), the highest cable car in France.



Day 06 LYON - PARIS

 Lyon - The beautiful city Lyon, listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is steeped in history and picturesque cobbled streets.
