DAY 1 : SINGAPORE - BUSAN (MOB)

Check in at Changi International Airport for your departure flight to Busan.

DAY 2 : BUSAN - GYEONGJU

(B/L: Busan Speciality Pork & Rice Set /D: Pumpkin Duck)

[Haeundae Blueline Park] Scenic views of Haeundae aboard an eco-friendly coastal train ride.

[Cheongsapo Daritdol Skywalk] A half-moon shaped glass floored streamlined observatory that offer a spectacular view of the city, sandy beaches, and the vast ocean!

[X the SKY] An observatory with ocean & city views on 98-100th floors of the tallest building in Busan

[Bulguksa Temple] An UNESCO World Heritage Site The temple a significant cultural and spiritual landmark, attracting visitors for both its historical value and natural beauty.

[Cheomseongdae Observatory] One of the oldest astronomical observatories in Asia, it was used to observe the stars and track celestial movements.

DAY 3 : GYEONGJU - POHANG - GYEONGJU

(B/L: Gamjatang /D: Korean BBQ)

[Igari Anchor Observatory] At a height of 10 meters above the ground, this 102-meter-long wooden deck provides stunning panoramic views of the East Sea.

[Hwanho Park Space Walk] Not a rollercoaster, but rather a massive sculptural staircase with dramatic twists and turns. This project is South Korea's largest contemporary public sculpture to date.

[Jukdo Market] A must visit to one of the biggest market in Korea.

[Homigot Sunrise Square] Famous for its stunning sunrise views and features a large hand sculpture symbolizing hope and new beginnings.

[Woljeonggyo Bridge] Scenic visit and photo-stop

[Donggung Palace & Wolji Pond] Scenic photo-stop at this artificial pond.

DAY 4 : GYEONGJU - ANDONG - DAEGU

(B/L: Andong Jimdak /D: Shabu Shabu)

[UNESCO World Heritage - Andong Hahoe Folk Village] An important aspect of Korean culture, it preserves Joseon-era architecture, folk traditions, rare books, and the longstanding tradition of clan-based villages.

[Andong Hanji Experience Center] Preserving Korean traditions through the production of

traditional paper.

[Woryeonggyo Bridge] "The shadow of the moon", longest pedestrian overpass made of wood spans the Nakdong River.

[Seomun Market] One of the oldest traditional market. The market is a great place to experience authentic Korean culture and traditional street food.

[Dongseongno Street] Central shopping district of Daegu.

DAY 5 : DAEGU - HAPCHEON - SANCHEONG - DAMYANG - GWANGJU

(B/L: Medicinal Herb and Mushroom Steamboat/ D: Charcoal Chicken BBQ)

[UNESCO World Heritage - Haeinsa Temple] Known for housing the Tripitaka Koreana, one of the most complete and oldest collections of Buddhist scriptures. Surrounded by serene nature, it is a significant cultural and spiritual landmark.

[Donguibogam Village] Serves as a cultural hub and a healing retreat, making it a fascinating destination for those interested in Korean heritage, wellness, and traditional oriental medicine. Enjoy Oriental Medicine Healing Experience - Herb Moxa Cautionary.

[Mureunggyo Suspension Bridge] This bridge spans across the beautiful Mureung Stream and offers stunning views of the surrounding natural landscapes, including lush forests, rocky terrain, and crystal-clear waters.

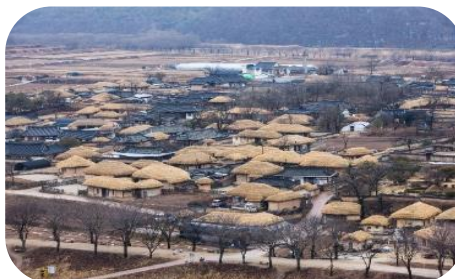

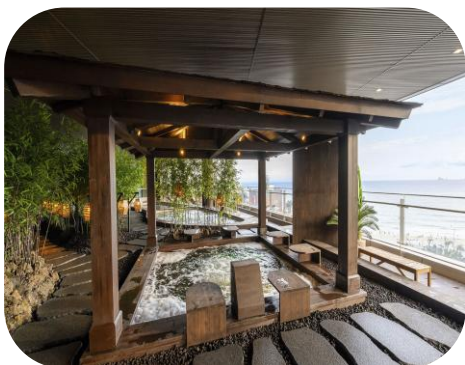
